CCG Cluster 2 (North) Profile, February 2019

Cluster 2 (North) Summary
CCG Cluster 2 average deprivation score (23.8) is far lower than Oldham CCG average (30.3) with the exception of Donald Wilde Medical Centre (38.4)
Average life expectancy in males (77.1) and females (81.7) in Cluster 2 is similar to Oldham average with exception of males at Donald Wilde Medical Centre (75.4). Life expectancy data is not available for The Parks Medical Practice.
Cluster 2 average prevalence is HIGHER than Oldham CCG average prevalence for the following health conditions: Dementia, Cancer, Coronary Heart Disease and Stroke & TIA
Cluster 2 average prevalence is SIMILAR to Oldham CCG average prevalence for the following health conditions: Mental Health, CKD, Diabetes, Longstanding health conditions, Hypertension, Asthma, COPD and Obesity. Where Cluster 2 also had similar rates to the Oldham CCG average but potentially requiring further local interpretation were in relation to: Reporting cancer in the last 5 years; Females aged 25-64 years with a record of cervical screening (last 5 yrs); Females aged 50-70 years screened for breast cancer in last 36 months (3 year coverage); Persons aged 60-69 years old screened for bowel cancer in last 30 months (2.5 year coverage); Emergency hospital admissions for all causes (under 18 years old) 2013/14-2015/16; and, A & E Attendance (under 18 years old) 2013/14-2015/16
Cluster 2 average prevalence is LOWER than Oldham CCG prevalence for the following health conditions: Depression and Learning disabilities.

**DONALD WILDE MEDICAL CENTRE** has **HIGHER** prevalence than Oldham CCG average for the following health conditions: CKD (more than 1.5 times CCG average), Diabetes and Hypertension ~ ~ **LOWER** prevalence of: Dementia, Depression, Learning disabilities, Mental Health, COPD and Obesity ~ ~ Also **LOWER** but potentially requiring further local interpretation were: Reporting cancer in the last 5 years; Persons aged 60-69 years screened for bowel cancer in last 30 months (2.5 year coverage); and, Emergency hospital admissions for all causes (aged under 18 years) 2013/14-2015/16

**THE PARKS MEDICAL PRACTICE** has **HIGHER** prevalence than Oldham CCG average for the following health conditions: Dementia, Cancer, Coronary heart disease, Hypertension and Obesity ~ ~ **LOWER** prevalence of: Depression (two-thirds CCG average), Learning disabilities, Mental Health and Asthma ~ ~ Also **LOWER** but potentially requiring further local interpretation were: Reporting cancer in the last 5 years (approaching one-third CCG average); and, Emergency hospital admissions for all causes (aged under 18 years) 2013/14-2015/16

**THE ROYTON & CROMPTON FAMILY PRACTICE** has **HIGHER** prevalence than Oldham CCG average for the following health conditions: Dementia, Cancer (approaching double CCG average) and Stroke & TIA ~ ~ Also **HIGHER** but potentially requiring further local interpretation were: Persons aged 60-69 years screened for bowel cancer in last 30 months (2.5 year coverage) ~ ~ **LOWER** prevalence of: Depression (two-thirds CCG average), Learning disabilities (less than two-thirds CCG average), Mental Health, CKD, Diabetes, COPD and Obesity

**OAK GABLES MEDICAL PRACTICE** has **HIGHER** prevalence than Oldham CCG average for the following health conditions: Dementia, Cancer (1.5 times CCG average), CKD, Coronary heart disease, Hypertension, Stroke & TIA, Asthma and COPD ~ ~ Also **HIGHER** but potentially requiring further local interpretation were: Reporting cancer in the last 5 years; Persons aged 60-69 years screened for bowel cancer in last 30 months (2.5 year coverage) ~ ~ **LOWER** prevalence of: Depression, Longstanding health conditions and Obesity ~ ~ Also **LOWER** but potentially requiring further local interpretation were: Emergency hospital admissions for all causes (aged under 18 years) 2013/14-2015/16

**VILLAGE MEDICAL PRACTICE** has **HIGHER** prevalence than Oldham CCG average for the following health conditions: Dementia, Depression (1.5 times CCG average), Mental Health, Longstanding health conditions, COPD (more than 1.5 times CCG average) and Obesity ~ ~ **LOWER** prevalence of: Learning disabilities (one-third CCG average), Cancer, Diabetes, Coronary Heart Disease and Stroke & TIA
